A new housing development has been built on the site that was once home to the Michael MacOwan Theatre – formerly part of LAMDA, the oldest drama school in the UK. The location is well known among A-list stars, having once been the school where British actors Benedict Cumberbatch and David Suchet trained, and is also a short distance from Garden Lodge, the former home of Queen's frontman Freddie Mercury.
